Microphones:

- 8 Shure SM58 Wireless Handheld Microphone

- 2 Shure CVG18-B Condenser Gooseneck Microphone
 - 1 located on the main lectern/podium
 - 1 located on mobile lectern/podium

Cameras:

- 3 Pan Tilt Zoom (PTZ) Cameras
 - (2) Front of the theater
 - (1) Back of the theater

Speakers:

- Full Surround Sound
 - (3) Bose speakers mounted front stage
 - (2) Bose subwoofers mounted front stage
 - (8) Bose surround speakers mounted on rear and side walls



Lighting:

- Full stage lighting with five presets:
 - Lectern Left: Front row lighting for the lectern on the left of the stage
 - Film: Low blue lighting for the full stage
 - Full Stage: All stage lighting on
 - Town Hall Meeting: Center stage brighten with edges dim (Screen cannot be used)
 - Cool White Stage: Front stage lighting set to a cooler light temperature
- Lighting Controls: Ion Xe Control Board
 - Ability to create lighting shows with software or within the control booth

XLR Input:

- 2 Wall-mounted XLR inputs available (Located on the left and right on stage)

XLR Output:

- 6 Wall-mounted XLR outputs available (Located on the front of stage)

Additional Equipment:

- 4 Floor Audio Wedges available for optimal sound distribution

Control Booth:

- Mixer: Allen & Heath SQ-7 48 channel digital mixer
 - 32 onboard preamps
 - 16 line outputs
 - 33 faders / 6 layers
 - 16 assignable softkeys
 - 8 assignable soft rotaries

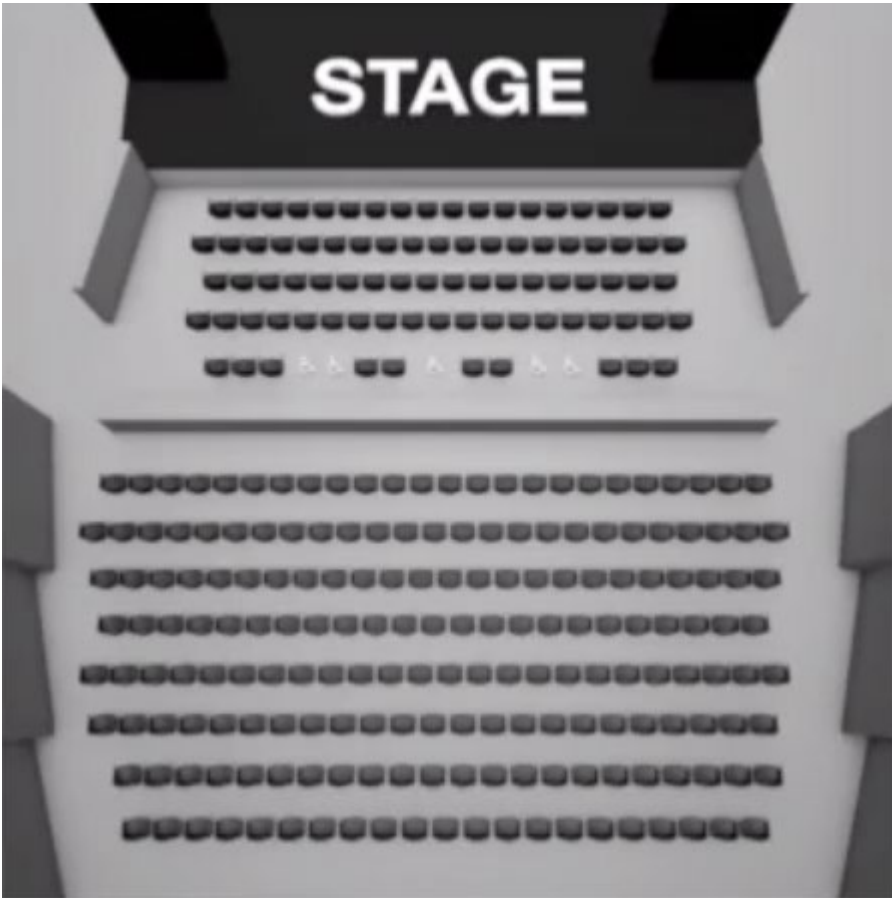


Seating Diagram and Ticketing
